Board further applies for an order to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be granted enjoining cross-defendants from committing the above-described acts during the pendency of this action. This application is made on the grounds that defendants are in violation of California Civil Code Sections 3479 (nuisance), Berkeley Municipal Code 13.52.020 (trespass), Penal Code § 647 (e) (disorderly conduct), Code of Civil Procedure Sections 735 (Forcible Entry damages), and on the further ground that great and irreparable injury will result to plaintiff before the matter can be heard on statutory notice.

Cross-Complainant has previously applied for a citizen's arrest to the Berkeley Police Department which after weeks of considering the matter, requested that Cross-Complainant obtain a Court order to abate the nuisance. Cross-Complainant requires access to the National Office to conduct its business and for its outside auditors to audit the Foundation's financial statements and to finalize its income tax return by the May 2014 extension deadline. Cross-Complainant needs access to the NO to determine money owed and when payments are due, and to send out notices of change of management. Cross-Defendant Reese continues to represent that she is in control of the Foundation to vendors and to the government by virtue of adversely possessing the Foundation's NO. Reese has already accepted Foundation's assets knowing that she is not entitled to the funds.

This application is based on the verified cross-complaint on file in this case, the Memorandum of Points and Authorities, and the Declaration of Margy Wilkinson filed herewith.
